# **Sewing Machine:**

The *Janome Derby* is the sewing machine we used in class. The red *(Bandana Blush)* model is the most reliable. They also come with a one year warranty.

## Tips for Sewing with Kids:

- 1. **Start small:** Start with a low stakes project. That will take less than 30 mins to finish.
- 2. Pre-cut fabric or cut together:
  This can save time and frustration.
  Tools are important, and most
  kid scissors and hands might
  struggle with the task.
- 3. Be patient: Slow down.

  Teaching children to sew is a slow process, many steps are brand new. You might get frustrated and they might as well. Take breaks if needed and keep it fun!
- 4. **Celebrate:** It might be imperfect, but we are all learning. Remember to celebrate your victories.
